

Andrew Browne & Orlando Agostino *Biography June 07*



Andrew and Orlando play a Sunday residency at Joes Cafe Deluxe in Kings Cross and other pubs, cafes and bars around Sydney. They have a devoted following for their tasteful, laid-back performance and their easygoing humour. The music is acoustic roots, jazz, blues and folk - gentle at times, with a real edge at others. Their original songs tell stories we're all familiar with yet give plenty to think about if you're in that kind of mood. And there's a depth of musicianship to bask in for those who just love listening.

Orlando Agostino plays guitar and mandolin and started off in folk clubs when he was just 16. He has been living and playing in Tamworth for a number of years and has played with some of the great Australian country, blues and roots musicians through the years. He performs with several singer-songwriters as he is in demand for his beautiful mastery of the acoustic roots guitar style. Orlando enhances the songs with sweet, strong arrangements that come straight from the heart yet show his fine technique and delicate precision.

Andrew Browne is a songwriter, guitarist and singer. He is originally from Christchurch, NZ and since moving to Australia has lived in Sydney and on the Hawkesbury River. He has played in bars, cafes, galleries and festivals from Woodford to WA - but mostly around Sydney and the NSW Central Coast. Andrew has a fine voice and a charming presence. His tunes are well crafted, melodic and accessible and his songs are about our everyday world - delivered with warmth, wit and intelligence.

Andrew also works as an actor in theatre and film, as an MC and host for events and has appeared in comedy debates and theatresports.

Andrew's songs are on The Anglers' CD, *Fishing For Compliments*, which receives airplay on ABC and he and Orlando have performed live-to-air for ABC Local Radio.
